Emergency food assistance is available M-F, but main food pantry distribution is held every Friday until noon. Clothing referrals may be given once every six months. Client needs a voucher, picture ID, and proof of address. Other programs include the state-wide Nicor Sharing Program for gas utility assistance and a Latino literacy program and limited rental assistance when funds are available.
